


What is Clinical Redesign

'Clinical Redesign' is an organisation performance improvement method that has brought about significant improvement into healthcare service delivery, worldwide. The method draws on a variety of tools that were initially developed within private industry (including the manufacturing industry), and adapts and extends these for use within health care settings. The focus of Clinical Redesign is to improve existing services and processes; the central goal of the method is to improve patient care.

This course is for anyone who is passionate about helping people and improving the way our health services are delivered to patients - whether you are a healthcare professional, a manager or a health executive. You will develop advanced problem solving and analytical skills to help identify and resolve service delivery blockages and inefficiencies that impact patient care. - Get involved in research and advance your career with a post-graduate qualification




Where it will lead you
